in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil**

Salon H is pleased to announce the opening of its 2023 programme in Rio de Janeiro, with the Dar Bandeira exhibition, which will open on 7 January 2023. "The expression "Dar bandeira" has many connotations in Portuguese, but one of them best defines this project, namely the transmission of a coded message through an artistic gesture. This project was born out of a need to celebrate the possibility of initiating a renewal in a country fractured by the social and economic situation. We want each flag to affirm its plurality in unity, and to contribute to the expression of the desire for a more democratic, fairer and more possible reality," explains curator Shannon Botelho.

The exhibition will occupy the entire exhibition space of the Villa da Ladeira, below the house designed by architect José Zanini Caldas in 1977.

This space will be dedicated to the programming of artistic events, in synergy with the activity of the H exhibition in Paris.

This inaugural project, where 19 flags will be raised, is a way to celebrate the opening of this new venue, and to show our commitment to the Brazilian art scene.
